

GLADWIN COUNTY BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS

MEETING MINUTES OF November 5, 2025

The regular meeting of the Gladwin County Board of Road Commissioners was held on Wednesday, November 4, 2025, at 9:30 a.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Greaves. Present were Commissioners Greaves, Batterbee & Cameron, Manager, Dave Pettersch and Secretary, Heather Cameron. A list of the others attending the meeting is attached to these minutes at the road commission office.

The minutes from October 22, 2025, the regular meeting was presented for approval. Motion was made by Commissioner Cameron and seconded by Commissioner Batterbee to approve the minutes as presented. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cameron and seconded by Commissioner Batterbee to approve the purchase of turkeys for each employee for the holiday season. The turkeys will be given out at the Christmas Safety Meeting in December. Motion Carried.

The MTF Estimated Distribution report for 2026 was reviewed.
