## #DESTINATION CLARE : ART SCULPTURE WALK

The #DestinationClare Art Sculpture Walk features an outdoor sculpture exhibit that is displayed year round. A selection committee is comprised of various local artists, business and community leaders. Each entry is evaluated on its artistic merit, creativity, public safety and durability in an outdoor setting. The committee selected 10 entries to be displayed in various locations across the main corridor of the downtown area for public viewing. The outdoor sculpture exhibit will be housed in downtown Clare now until April 30, 2026. The sculpture artists are eligible to win cash awards, as well as having their piece voted through "People's Choice" voting.

## ART RELOAN PROGRAM

The Clare County Arts Council (CCAC) established the reloan program to increase the presence of art in Clare County. This program offers businesses and organizations the opportunity to lease one of the previous years art installations for one year for a fee. 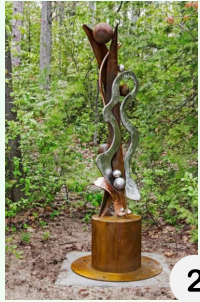
