



Monthly Fire Department Activity Report

December 2021 Incident Response:

Monthly Total: 37 Year End Total: 269

December was a record-breaking month with 37 calls up from 14 calls last month. We responded to nine car accidents, three with injuries and six without injuries. We had one car fire. There was one structure fire in our district that caused minor damage to a pole barn where we found a fire in the wall. We responded to one request for mutual aid from Coleman FD for a tender on a structure fire. We responded to 18 Weather related incidents due to high winds. These involved trees down blocking the road, trees down with power lines, trees down in the power lines causing them to arc. We had a single wide trailer where a tree fell on the trailer while the home owner was still inside. There were no injuries with exception to the home which was literally cut in half. The grand finale for 2021 was the water rescue of a female driver. She was rescued from her partially submerged vehicle in the tobacco river, just below the dam. She was not injured and was transported and treated for hypothermia. Other incidents as listed.
