- 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER.</u> Chairman Jim Allen called this regular meeting of the Clare Downtown Development Authority to order at 8:00 a.m. at Clare City Hall and subsequently led the Pledge of Allegiance. - 2. <u>APPROVAL OF AGENDA.</u> Motion by Gus Murphy and supported by Shari Buccilli to approve the Agenda as presented. The Agenda was unanimously approved.
- 3. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>. Motion by Mary Ann Shurlow and supported by Vince Demasi to accept the minutes as presented. Minutes unanimously approved.
- 4. **OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS.** None.
- 5. **NEW BUSINESS.**
 - **A.** Façade Improvement 601 McEwan. Ms. Gus Murphy, the owner of the downtown buildings located at 601 N.
