RE: Liquor License Local Approval – BEA, Inc. (Buccilli’s Pizza of Clare)

For the Agenda of January 17, 2022

Background. The City has received a request for the approval of a Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC) Class C license from Shari Buccilli to allow her to make application to the LCC to serve beer and wine to dine-in customers at Buccilli’s Pizza of Clare.

Issues & Questions Specified. Should the City Commission approve the Class C license?

Alternatives.

1. Recommend approval of the license.
2. Recommend disapproval of the license.
3. Set aside the matter for further discussion and consideration at a subsequently scheduled public meeting.

Financial Impact. Recommendation of approval of the license will likely provide additional sales and customers for the business, thereby increasing revenues for this business.

Recommendations. I recommend that the City Commission approve of the license by adoption of Resolution 2022-006 (copy *att’d*).
