RE: Lake Shamrock Hydraulic Dredging Bids

For the Agenda of March 6, 2023

Background. The City recently solicited bids for the hydraulic dredging of Lake Shamrock. The proposals include project management, permit application and administration, site preparation, and completion of hydraulic dredging of approximately 150,000 cubic yards of material from Lake Shamrock. Final depths will be as per the original permit which will approximately match the original 1962 lake depths.

Two bids were received at the bid opening (*see copy of att'd Bid Memo*). The low bid was submitted by Savin Lake Services, Inc. for an amount of \$2,319,000.00.

The City Commission is asked to approve the low bid amount of \$2,319,000.00 and award the work to Savin Lake Services, Inc.

Issues & Questions Specified. Should the City Commission approve the bid and award the hydraulic dredging project work to the low bidder?

Alternatives.

1. Approve the bid and award the hydraulic dredging project work to Savin Lake Services, Inc., the low bidder.
2. Approve the bids and award the hydraulic dredging project work to the other bidder.
3. Direct the solicitation of new bids.
4. Direct that no hydraulic dredging work be completed.
5. Set aside a decision regarding this matter to a later date.

Financial Impact. The City Commission approved a 1.3 million-dollar bond with the cost of the special assessment being split 50/50 between lakefront property owners and the City at large in 2020. The following year, the city was awarded 6.8 million to complete the Lake Shamrock Dredging, spillway, and dam replacement project. This amount is more than adequate to cover the costs of the low bid, \$2,319,000.00.

Recommendation. I recommend that the City Commission approve the bids for the City's Lake Shamrock Hydraulic Dredging Project and award the work for the project to Savin Lake Services, Inc. by adoption of Resolution 2023-019 (*copy att'd*).

WHEREAS, the Clare City Commission has reviewed and considered the recommendations of its staff and deemed same to be reasonable and prudent.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Clare, hereby approves the Lake Shamrock hydraulic dredging project bids and awards the work outlined in the bid specifications to Savin Lake Services, Inc. for a cost not to exceed \$2,319,000.00.
